

Desert Princess Women's Golf Club Tuesday & Saturday Playday Guidelines

As approved by the Executive Board of Directors October 1, 2025

Sign-Up:

- 1. www.dpwgc.com
- 2. www.desertprincesscountryclub.com

Registration Schedule:

- **Full Members** may sign up starting the 1st of the month for the Tuesday and Saturday playdays for the following month. For example, sign up October 1 for the month of November.
- **Associate Members** are eligible to play in all Tuesday and Saturday playday games. They may sign up starting the 15th of the month for the Tuesday and Saturday playdays for the following month. For example, sign up October 15 for the month of November.
- **Guests** Members may invite one guest to play with them on any Tuesday or Saturday playday, space permitting. Guests may play no more than two regular Tuesday or Saturday playdays during the high season (Nov-April). Guests may be invited to play any Tuesday or Saturday during the off season if space is available. Guests are not eligible to play in the "game" of the day.

Registration Notification:

- **Entries**: for playdays will be closed 3 days in advance of play. Pro Shop will send out tee sheets no later than 2 days in advance of play.
- 1. **Cancellations**: after the tee sheets have been distributed, must be made through the pro shop. Please consult the Standing Rules to review the cancellation policy applicable to all golf events.

Games of the Day:

- Game of the day will be announced when you check in.
- Cost of the game \$4.00 exact amount preferred NO COINS
- No separate game card is required.
- The results of the game of the day and payouts will be announced once all scores are in and verified. Results are also posted on the DPWGC website.

Participant Check In: PLEASE follow the guidelines below:

Specific to TUESDAY:

- 7:30am Check in opens. Playday Captains will be at the entrance into the restaurant.
- 8:00am Check in closes.
- 8:30am Shotgun start.

Specific to SATURDAY:

- Check in 15 minutes before your tee time.
- Playday Captains will be at the entrance into the restaurant.

Scorecards:

- DO NOT PICK UP FOR YOUR MAX ON ANY GAME COUNTING HOLE OR RISK ELIMINATION FROM THE PLAYDAY COMPETITION. If you are out of the hole or picked up for your max on any other non-counting hole enter the maximum hole score in Golf Genius. Golf Genius is unable to submit an X to GHIN. Maximum hole score for posting purposes is a net double bogey which is equal to two above par plus any handicap strokes you receive based on your Course Handicap.
- Official scorecards, prepared by the Pro Shop, will be provided for each team ONE person will keep this card. Mark any birdies and/or chip-ins clearly on this official scorecard.
- Golf Genius will be used for scoring the game ONE person (different from the official scorecard keeper) must enter the scores in the software app on a hole-by-hole basis.
- At the end of the game, these two scorekeepers must verify all scores and then sign the official scorecard.
- Return the official scorecard to the Pro Shop.

Posting of Scores:

- Participants scores are entered in GHIN by the Pro Shop for both Tuesday and Saturday playday rounds.
- If you do not post your scores through GHIN (Golf Handicap Information Network), you must post your score using Golf Canada or another World Handicapping System on the day you play your round.
